This application must be submitted to the History Dept. office by **February 1**.

**Purpose:** The purpose of the Classics Summer Study Travel Stipend is to support USU Classics students who wish to attend an approved summer program of Greek or Latin study in the US or classics-related study in Europe.

In addition to this application form, students must submit a **current academic transcript**. If you are selected to receive a stipend, you will be asked to submit a **detailed budget** before the stipend is awarded. Recipients of the stipend will write a **brief report** (500 words or fewer) addressed to the History Department Head about their experience in the program for which the award was received. Awardees may also be asked to make a **presentation** to the Classics program about their experience the previous summer.
